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


- STEMMER started in 1972

#### A HISTORY OF INVENTION








- ▶ 1698 Tom Savery invented the first steam engine








Top 10 \$ billion 2013

#### MANUFACTURING OUTPUT PER HEAD




#### ► MANUFACTURING OUTPUT % GDP



#### Top 10 countries importing UK manufactured goods







#### ▶ UK MACHINE VISION MARKETS OBSERVATIONS









- UK Car production is making more cars than ever
  - ▶ Most car manufacturing plants are designed outside the UK and shipped in
  - Jaguar/Land Rover is the exception
  - Automotive market share is probably a lot higher than reported
- ► Non manufacturing applications are significant
  - ► Sports/entertainment/.broadcast
  - Infrastructure
  - Medical
  - Food



#### BUSINESS CULTURE AND THE IRISH DIFFERENCE







- Economic approach is heavily influenced by the US compared to Europe
- Strong Innovation and can do attitude

- Irish have a stronger culture of personal Irish to Irish business
- Ireland has had strong government incentives for manufacturing
  - Strong in contract manufacturing
- ▶ Ireland has attractive corporation tax regime for selling in to Europe
  - Many global mv companies sell from Ireland in Europe



















#### ► INVESTMENTS ARE SLOWING





#### WHAT THE EXPERTS SAY





- ► If Brexit does NOT happen
  - Exchange rates likely to rally to 1.35 €/£
  - ► Investment uncertainty will lift
  - Expect a recovery of recent softening of the market

- If a Brexit happens
  - Exchange rates will drop to 1.1 €/£
  - ► GDP will be 6% lower that it otherwise would be by 2030
  - ► Likely to enter recession within 2 years
